Cabernet Sauvignon

Stellenbosch is perhaps the most famous wine-producing region in [South Africa](#).

Perfect harmony between fruit and wood. Extremely well-balanced **wine** with velvety tannins. Deep garnet colour, Medium to full bodied **wine** with long lingering nuances of plum, cassis, cedar on the aftertaste.

'12 Chateau St Georges, Bordeaux

\$135

St.-Georges offering notes of damp earth, forest floor, black cherries, spicy, masculine personality. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannin, well balanced with crisp acidity, more black fruit emerging towards the finish accompanied by tobacco and cedar.

2018 Domaine Faiveley Mercurey, Pinot Noir, Burgundy, France Premier Cru "Le Clos Du Roy"

\$ 145

Deep ruby red in colour with notes of fresh red fruits and spice on the nose. This wine is a pleasure to drink thanks to its smooth, fruity attack and delicate, silky tannins.

'16 Chateau Mont Redon Chateau neuf du Pape Grenache Shiraz

\$148

A classic style from Chateau Neuf, it carries a lot of length, dark forest fruits with bright cherries, the wine is all about the tannin structure, which is your overall mouth feel. Leaving a luscious lasting integrated feel of balance and harmony between the fruit acid and structure.

'17 St Joseph Rouge, Domaine Aurelien Chatagnier, Syrah, Nth Rhone

\$150

The wine is juicy and dark-fruited, marked by an impeccable balance.

2009 Chateau Labegorce Margaux, Bordeaux

\$165

Bordering one of the world's most famous vineyards this is a hidden gem which feels like a grand cru.

Your typical Bordeaux blend being predominantly Cabernet sauvignon it carries length and complexity, from perfectly integrated oak comes amazing Hughes of dark chocolate and great herbal notes. Really expressive, with a gorgeous beam of raspberry, blackberry and blueberry fruit driving through, inlaid with graphite and anise notes. The very polished feel lets the fruit glisten on the finish.

2014 Cornas Domaine Auguste Clape, Syrah, Rhone Valley, France

\$355

Brilliant purple. Powerful, mineral-tinged cherry and blackberry scents, along with notes of bacon fat, liquorice, potpourri and pungent flowers. Pure, concentrated and energetic on the palate, offering deeply concentrated black and blue fruit flavours that gain weight and become sweeter with air. Closes extremely long, sappy and sweet, juicy acidity adding lift and cut to the blue-fruit-dominated, youthfully tannic finish.

Premium Australian Red Wines

2016 Wirra Wirra The Angelus McLaren Vale, Cabernet Sav SA **\$ 134**
Dry, full bodied. The nose shows fragrant red and black currant, a forest-floor earthiness and briary, tobacco-leaf character.

2015 Yalumba Tri Centenary Grenache Barossa Valley, SA **\$139**
The fresh, red-floral perfume and the raspberry and redcurrant aromas are so fresh.

2015 Yalumba The Signature Barossa Valley, Cabernet Shiraz, VIC **\$ 146**
Medium to full in body, there's a refined feel to the rich blackcurrant, liquorice and blackberry fruit which is intertwined with vanillin cedar, light earth and spice.

2011 Domaine A Merlot, Tasmania **\$ 165**
There are hints of liquorice, strawberries, the tannins are starting to melt and it's just beautiful and riveting. On the nose it exudes intense black cherry, plum, forest berries and dark chocolate aromas.

2015 Barossa Valley Estate 2015 E & E Black Pepper Shiraz **\$175**
Pronounced black fruit and violet notes, with black pepper spice and rich dark plum, seamlessly lingering with elegant fine-grained tannins

2015 Yalumba Octavius Shiraz, Barossa Valley, SA **\$ 284**
Exhibits savoury notes of red currants followed by dried herb aromatics, leading into almost sweet and sour plums.

Premium White Wines

2018 Roche Noir, Domaine Lathuilliere, Beaujolais Blanc, France

\$ 98

Fresh, mineral, generous white flowers aromas, slight iris aromas, slight lime blossom aromas, peach aromas, subtle oak aromas. Elegant, rich, citrus hints, slight gunflint hints, smooth, slightly mineral, light body, discreet intensity, good length.

2019 Pascal Jolivet Sancerre Sauvignon Blanc Loire Valley, France

\$115

Fresh, clean and screaming with racy acidity. On the palate it is fresh and tightly wound; acidity is tempered by very subtle residual sugar; very clean; alive, racy, dry, and youthful.

2013 Marc Bredif Vouvray, Classic Chenin Blanc, Loire Valley, France

\$ 115

The attack is gentle with a lovely vivacity where one finds agreeable notes of grapefruit on the lingering finish. It is a lovely wine, ripe and refreshing. On the nose, there is a fine bouquet full aromas of white flowers and yellow fruit such as pears. One finds citrus notes such as grapefruit.

Premium Champagne

Pol Roger Brut Reserve, Champagne Epernay, France

\$116

Pol Roger Brut Réserve displays a beautiful golden straw-coloured hue, as well as abundant and fine bubbles. With a powerful and attractive nose, it first delivers aromas of fruit (pear, mango ...) and then releases light flavours of honeysuckle and white jasmine, lingering on vanilla and brioche notes. Behind a frank and dynamic attack, the wine encompasses a nice harmony and a pleasant freshness, whilst preserving some structure. On the palate, flavours of cooked fruit (quince jelly, apricot jam) happily mingle with fragrances of beeswax and acacia honey. The long-lasting aromas, composed of both fruity (candied orange peel, tangerine...) and spicy notes (cardamom, anis) is outstanding

Jean Cédric Deguy, Champagne France

Golden pale robe. Discreet fruity noose, with apple then notes of raspberry. A very fresh straight champagne for aperitif.

Champagne Comtes de Dampierre - Blanc de blancs, France Brut 1er Cru Vertus

\$125

The Family Dampierre is one of the oldest branches of the House of France: for more than seven centuries, their name has been closely linked with the history of the Champagne area. Comte Audoin de Dampierre's great grandfather cemented the family ties with the production of champagne. From 1880, he brought to the trade, his "savoir-faire" and a constant quest for quality, which continues today. Maintaining this tradition, the Count de Dampierre selects only wines from Grand Cru and Premier Cru vineyards.

2019 Petit F... Pouilly Fume, Sauvignon Blanc Loire France

\$ 128

A very gracious Pouilly Fumé with attractive crushed blackcurrant, leaf aromas and a hint of exotic fruit. In the palate this is a graceful wine, pure and rounded in style, with hints of bright fresh currants. Characteristically refreshing on the finish, fine, long and beautifully appealing.

2018 Chateau Mont Redon Chateau Neuf du Pape, Blanc France

\$ 130

Grenache Blanc

Bright yellow with green highlights. Nose: spicy aromas fine white peach, apricot and quince. Mouth: The enormous density of fruit, powerful, mineral, refreshing acidity, very persistent and balanced.

2017 Saint Veran Chardonnay, Burgundy, France

\$ 149

Domaine Sophie Cinier. Lovely peach and honeysuckle nose, gently oaked it cossets the palate with toasty vanilla essence and it has a mild creamy texture to the peach and pineapple fruit, countered by a smooth lime citrus blade.

Champagne & Sparkling Wines

2018 Alasia Moscato, Piemonte, Italy

\$ 58

Light gold in colour, powerful aromas of honey, flowers and fresh grapes. Intensely sweet palate with flavours of grapes and citrus and finishing cleanly with refreshing acidity.

Veuve D'Argent Blanc de Blancs, Burgundy, France

\$ 65

Golden-tinted colour with delicate bubbles and a fine foam. Floral and nutty bouquet (hazelnut, almond). A lively and fresh attack. Round on the palate with honeyed aromas.

Louis Bouillot Perle d'Ivoire, Blanc de Blancs, Burgundy, France

\$ 78

The nose develops aromas of citrus and flowers, evolving to butter and brioche notes with age. The palate is round and intense, with very complex secondary aromas.

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Rosé Wines

2019 Triennes Rose Provence, France

\$ 62

Bright and summery with strawberries, pomegranate spritz and rich vanilla aromas.

2018 Reserve Cotes Du Rhone Rose Rhone, France

\$67

The 2018 has finesse and is delicate, well balanced, with a nice minerality and a saline character. It reveals gourmet notes on the palate and a nice length.

2019 Château La Valetanne La Valetanne Rosé

\$70

Pale colour. Beautiful nose, very provençal with peach and citrus flavours. The mouth is textural with a nice acidity that keeps it refreshing but serious. A rosé you can't stop sipping!!!

White Wines

Grenache Blanc, Semillon, Sauvignon Blanc

2020 Wirra Wirra Hiding Champion Sav Blanc, Adelaide, SA \$ 48

Passionfruit, gooseberry and freshly squeezed citrus dominate, followed by more subtle grassy, leafy notes and a touch of kaffir lime.

2020 Twin Islands Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, NZ \$ 55

It has an intense aroma combining citrus peel, passionfruit and fresh garden herb notes. The palate shows grapefruit and papaya flavours with hints of bell pepper and thyme which leads to a refreshing juicy finish.

2016 Les Sorceries, Grenache Blanc Cotes de Roussillon, France \$ 65

This aromatic blend of Grenache Blanc, Vermentino (aka Rolle), Roussanne and Macabeu is a wonderfully refreshing, citrusy and camomile-scented mineral white with sufficient weight to partner fish or chicken.

2019 Brokenwood Hunter Semillon Hunter Valley, NSW \$ 72

Lifted grapefruit and lime zest aromas that are typical of young Semillon. Great line and length with a zippy acid backbone. Slightly richer in style than previous years with lovely citrus pith flavours.

2018 Domaine Octavie Touraine, Sauvignon Blanc, France \$ 82

Papaya, pineapple and citrus on the nose. 4.0 Light straw colour. Liads of grapefruit melon citrus gooseberry and nettles. Balanced acidity, concentrated, elegant and complex.

2018 Roche Noir, Domaine Lathuilliere, Beaujolais Blanc, France \$ 98

Fresh, mineral, generous white flowers aromas, slight iris aromas, slight lime blossom aromas, peach aromas, subtle oak aromas. Elegant, rich, citrus hints, slight gunflint hints, smooth, slightly mineral, light body, discreet intensity, good length.

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Riesling, Pinot Blanc, Chenin Blanc

2017 Clarence House Estate Pinot Blanc, Tasmania

\$ 57

Expansive citrus and pear on the palate, but with excellent focus and lift thanks to spice, mineral and tangy peppery notes. The flavours build and deepen into the finish, which is wonderfully fresh and quite long. Gooseberry aromas with depth and character without overt herbaceous character.

2020 Jim Barry JB Riesling , Clare Valley, SA

\$ 62

Pale straw colour in the glass. The nose is vibrant with clean, fresh cut citrus and a hint of lime. Palate has lashings of flavour with a generous fruit salad of honeydew melon and lemon rind. The finish is classic, clean and moreish.

2016 Trimbach Riesling, Alsace, France

\$ 68

A classic and one of the all-time greats.

The natural oils coming through entice anyone's gums, it has the kerosene that would be expected from any Riesling from Alsace with great minerals. Bright straw-yellow. Green apple, white flowers and a note of powdered stone on the nose and palate. Juicy, spicy and nicely delineated, finishing with lovely mineral tang and lemony acidity.

2013 Marc Bredif Vouvray, Classic Chenin Blanc, Loire Valley, France

\$ 115

The attack is gentle with a lovely vivacity where one finds agreeable notes of grapefruit on the lingering finish. It is a lovely wine, ripe and refreshing.

2019 Corte Giara Pinot Grigio Della Venezia, Italy

A dry, crisp wine with elegant floral notes and a subtle apple crunch. A sure-fire winner with its dry, racy palate and good depth and definition.

2019 Cork Cutters Grigio, Marlborough New Zealand

\$ 58

Marlborough Pinot Gris was sourced in the very north area of New Zealand, known to be the most ideal place to grow Pinot Gris. Fresh pears and apples couple with spices to create a lingering wine which is full of flavour.

2018 Hugel Gentil, Alsace, France

\$ 92

Grapes Pinot Gris, Riesling, Pinot Blanc. The bouquet is youthful and refreshing, spontaneously expressing an agreeable aroma of green apple, pear, lychee, passion fruit, rose and the lightest touch of Muscat.

2019 Mt Difficulty Bannockburn Pinot Gris, NZ

\$ 72

Aromas of white peach and pear blossom mingled with underlying crisp red apple notes. Such a beautifully vibrant wine.

2016 Heggies Reserve Chardonnay, Eden Valley, SA

\$ 78

Complex aromas of citrus curd, stone fruit and fresh figs with notes of struck flint, brioche and a hint of spicy French oak.

2017 Dalrymple Cave Block Chardonnay, Pipers River, TAS

\$82

The 2016 vintage has a generous finish, fine acidity and dry through the palate, giving life and focus to the fruit flavours.

2018 William Fevre Petit Chablis Chardonnay, Chablis, France

\$ 88

Fruity and floral characters, along with the regions typical mineral notes ensure it is light and lively on the palate.

2017 Saint Veran Chardonnay, Burgundy, France

2018 Palliser Estate Pencarrow Pinot Noir, Martinborough, NZ **\$ 62**

The nose exhibits wild strawberry, cherry and spice aromas.

2020 Hughes and Hughes, Pinot Noir, Tasmania, TAS **\$ 68**

Tasmanian pinot with a twist, this natural pinot is receiving huge acclaims that are making it a cult wine, with nice length and paired very well with food this pinot drinks well above its price range. It has lovely bright fruit, cherries and strawberries up from with a well-integrated oak aspect.

2019 Brokenwood, Pinot Noir, Beechworth, VIC **\$ 72**

Lifted red cherry over sweet earthy savoury characters with a touch of oak sweetness.

2018 Dalrymple Pinot Noir, Tasmania, AU **\$ 75**

Ripe dark cherry, strawberry and anise flavour profile underscored by subtlety toasted cedar and forest floor characters.

2018 Domaine Faiveley Mercurey, Pinot Noir, Burgundy, France **\$ 145**
Premier Cru "Le Clos Du Roy"

2018 Bernard Metrat Chiroubles, Beaujolais, Burgundy, France

Rich cherry and red fruit aromas with a touch of aniseed and exotic spices. Full and deep palate backed by fine silky tannins

2018 Domaine des Bonnetieres Beaujolais, Burgundy, France

\$ 79

Deep red in colour, shows a wonderful sweet, pure fruit character as cherries and blackberries with a haunting complexity. Light and filled with juicy red fruits.

2013 Chapelle L'Isle Bordeaux Superieur Bordeaux, Merlot France

Light and fruity. Nice taste of French oak and light cherry. Smooth chocolate aftertaste

2016 JJ Vincent Julienas Beaujolais Cru, Burgundy, France

Vibrant red berry fruits, fragrant spices and delicate floral aromas on a smooth, silky texture

2016 Villacampa Roble Tempranillo, Ribera del Duero, Spain

\$ 65

Washed by the Duero River, Villacampa is located at the western most side of Castilla y León region, in the Valladolid and Zamora provinces. 90% Tempranillo, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon.

Classic and traditional wine made from Tempranillo 100%. Cherry red colour. Exquisitely fruity. On the nose, its rich aromas have a pronounced intensity with an initial scent of ripe red fruit followed by gentle sweet notes of vanilla and spices. Pleasantly tasty in its palate, structured and with good acidity.

2012 Chateau St Georges, Bordeaux

This satellite appellation has turned out a very good 2012 St.-Georges offering notes of damp earth, forest floor, black cherries and black currants in its medium-bodied, spicy, masculine personality

Australian

2018 Epsilon Shiraz Barossa Valley, SA **\$ 52**

Smoky cedar, dried meat and pepper notes follow. Rich and moreish, flooding the mouth are delicious dark plum, liquorice, blackberry and ripe blueberry fruits.

2018 Heathcote Shiraz, Heathcote, VIC **\$ 55**

The palate is full of rich firm tannins with notes of strawberry, caramel and all-spice.

2018 Saddlers Creek, Shiraz, Hunter Valley, NSW **\$55**

Generous fruit balance oak medium bodied.

2018 Yalumba Galway Shiraz, Barossa Valley, SA **\$ 57**

Aromas of blood plum, Christmas pudding and five spice that speak of its varietal and regional origins. Ripe and generous, flavours of mulberries, mocha and hints of beetroot.

2018 Langmeil Prime Cut, Shiraz, Barossa Valley, VIC **\$ 59**

Ripe and juicy berries flow across the medium to full-bodied palate with youthful tannins adding structure and balance to the sweet fruit. Hints of briary spice and pepper flow with the juicy fruit through to the finish.

2017 Jim Barry Lodge Hill Shiraz, Clare Valley, SA **\$ 62**

Aromatics of red and black berry fruits, a lift of violet florals, clove spice and mixed garden herbs.

2019 Langmeil Longmile Shiraz, Barossa Valley, SA **\$ 68**

On the nose aroma of Satsuma plum and mulberry fruits, mingle with floral and herbal notes and hints of liquorice all sorts and white pepper.

2018 Vasse Felix Shiraz, Margaret River, WA **\$ 82**

A great Margaret River Shiraz with temperate ripening conditions promoting fruit intensity, richness and fine tannins.

2019 Ministry of Clouds Shiraz, McLaren Vale, SA

\$ 75

Full bodied, dense black colour, intense blackberry & liquorice aromas. Rich blackberry, blueberry, black berry flavours. Cool blue and red fruit lift with layers of spice to entice, supported by a gentle old-oak creaminess, which progresses to the palate exhibiting bright, nervy, and fleshy persistence filed down nicely by fine and savoury tannins.

2018 Le Mas, Syrah & Grenache, Domaine Clavel, France **\$ 88**

*Lovely floral black cherry nose with some peppery hints, and some wet stones. The palate is juicy
and bright but has lovely depth of cherry fruit with a touch of meatiness and some gravelly grip.
This wine is juicy, deep, finishing long.*

2016 Lirac, Grenache Noir & Syrah, Chateau Boucarut, France **\$90**

*Ruby red color, notes of dark fruits, garrigue, pepper, oriental spices and leather.
Med+ tannins, good body.*

**2016 Chateau Mont Redon, Chateau neuf du Pape, Grenache Shiraz,

*The layering of flavours and depth of tannin is immense intense raspberry and black currant
compote notes form the core, which is dense in feel, with melted liquorice, singed anise and
warm fruitcake flavours filling in around the fruit.*

2018 Wirra Wirra Church Block, Cabernet Sauvignon, McLaren Vale \$ 58

Rich red and black fruits fill the mouth. Raspberry, red currant and plum fruits are balanced with fine sandy tannins and cedar oak.

2019 Tomfoolery Son of a Gun, Cabernet Sauvignon, Barossa Valley, SA \$60

Toasty, chocolatey, clovey blackberries. It's warm and round, with luxurious fruit.

2018 Langmeil Blacksmith, Cabernet Sauvignon, Barossa Valley, SA \$ 68

Lifted blueberries, red currants and black olive dominate the aroma with biscuit, cedar, liquorice and hints of menthol adding to the complexity.

2017 Vasse Felix Premiere, Cabernet Sauvignon, Margaret River, WA \$ 97

Mid bodied, mulberry and blackberry-fruited, with a peppering of cocoa and coffee grounds.

2015 Reyneke Cornerstone, Cabernet Sauvignon, Stellenbosh, South Africa \$110

Stellenbosch is perhaps the most famous wine-producing region in [South Africa](#).

Dry, full bodied. The nose shows fragrant red and black currant, a forest-floor earthiness and briary, tobacco-leaf character.

Syrah

2017 Frederic & Daniel Brunier Le Pigeoulet Vin de Pays du Vaucluse, Grenache Noir & Syrah, Rhone Valley **\$89**

This has a brambly and wild array of red and dark berries, as well as plush red plum, cherry and raspberry fruits. Very vibrant. A terrific vintage of this wine.

2017 St Joseph Rouge, Domaine Aurelien Chatagnier Syrah, Rhone, France **\$148**

The wine is juicy and dark-fruited, marked by an impeccable balance.

2014 Cornas Domaine Auguste Clape, Syrah, Rhone Valley, France **\$355**

Brilliant purple. Powerful, mineral-tinged cherry and blackberry scents, along with notes of bacon fat, liquorice, potpourri and pungent flowers. Pure, concentrated and energetic on the palate, offering deeply concentrated black and blue fruit flavours that gain weight and become sweeter with air. Closes extremely long, sappy and sweet, juicy acidity adding lift and cut to the blue-fruit-dominated, youthfully tannic finish.
